Our INtegrated SPInal-cord REhabilitation (INSPIRE) Centre, that is into its third year of operations deploys a uniquely experiential, 'one-of-a-kind' framework that offers individualised and holistic treatment options. Our rehabilitation services aim to optimise self-reliance from a physiological, psychological and socio-economic perspective.

This year we have successfully transformed the lives of more than 100 Persons with Spinal Cord Injury, transforming those who came in as caterpillars into colourful butterflies with the ability to reintegrate into society

drive to take it forward, with your love, support and blessing.






SOULFREE 2024 – 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

One of Soulfree's oldest and most impactful drives has been our gift box donation drive. It is our effort to restore the sense of value and dignity, and provide a sense of hope and happiness to our beneficiaries. Our gift box provides them with their medical and day-to-day essentials. This year, we have supported 1603 beneficiaries, who live below the line of poverty.

SOULFREE HOSPITAL COT, MATTRESS AND AIRBED DRIVE

After hearing about beneficiaries who were forced to lie on the floor, Soulfree took a strong decision that we would traverse through the many challenges regarding price and size of Hospital cots, mattresses and airbeds and provide these to our beneficiaries as a set to ensure their comfort, safety and prevention of bedsores. This time Soulfree started the new year providing 100 Hospital beds. The total investment for this drive was a more than 15 Lakh. We were overwhelmed when many of our beneficiaries called to express their deepest gratitude and said that this "was the best gift they had ever received in their lives." Airbeds have been provided separately for those with bedsores as well.

Amutha from Vellore, a paraplegic due to a bus Accident says, "Akka (they fondly address Our Founder Preethi Srinivasan as Elder Sister or "Akka"), With Preethi ma'am voice message on bedsores and proper use of Airbed, I am free of bedsore after eight years"

Sundar from Kanyakumari, had a fall while he was working on a construction site. Having recently lost his mother said "Madam, thank you for letting me know there is someone out there willing to take care of us"







SOULFREE MANUAL WHEELCHAIR AND CUSHION DRIVE

A suitable wheelchair is an essential and existential need for any individual facing permanent paralysis after spinal cord injury. Soulfree has always recognised this, but this year, we did 217 wheelchairs in a single drive, which was tremendously challenging as well as fulfilling for us.

Soulfree provides not only wheelchairs with precise specifications to suit PwSCI, we also provide gel embedded cushion that are specially designed to minimise bedsores along with each new wheelchair. Others who have wheelchairs but are facing pressure sores have been provided cushions separately as well.

Dhanasekaran P from Namakkal a Quadriplegic with 3 kids and his wife a daily-wage worker, was delighted on receiving the wheelchair cushion. He says "Preethi Ma'am, this is the first gift I have received since my accident". He wipes his tears and says, "I will not cry I will be brave like Preethi Ma'am!" Malliswari P from Erode is elated that she can now sit for extended hours working with her tailoring machine and this will help get more orders. Without the customised wheelchair and cushion I used be in too much pain to sit for more than an hour or two.

SOULFREE TAILORING MACHINE DRIVE

As much as physical and psychological wellbeing are important for PwSCI, for restoration of dignity and reintegration into society, socio-economic and primarily financial sustainability is paramount. Soulfree takes great pride in its one-of-a-kind vocational rehabilitation program that has produced many entrepreneurs. To this end, we are providing certification courses in tailoring at our centre but without an automated tailoring machine, our butterflies would not be able to start earning on their own. Therefore, in the last financial year, Soulfree has provided 75 tailoring machines, which has created income generation of vital importance to their families.

FEEDBACK FROM OUR DELIGHTED BENEFICIARIES

Our beneficiaries for more than 2 years now, Mr Lingam has received quite a bit of support from our outreach programs including wheelchair and hospital bed. However, with his wife struggling as a daily-wage worker, the 43-year-old was struggling to educate his daughter. Now, the tailoring machine is helping him earn for himself and his family.

The 23-year-old hard-working and enterprising youngster, Mr Prakash sustained a spinal-cord injury after a terrible electric shock at his workplace in 2020. He has been supporting his family, as they face of use and many struggles because of his alcoholic father, by running a small shop. With the help of our sewing machine, he is providing this additional service to his community and thereby is greatly improved his chances of significantly improving income. This Positive and enthusiastic youngster is thrilled and happy.

"I want to be a motivation to all SCI, just like Preethi ma'am. I want to become a role model like her and someday hope to support others like me, not just my family. Just like Soulfree has helped me today, I hope to empower others to face life like I am.



SOULFREE MONTHLY STIPEND PROGRAM

More than half of our beneficiaries come from broken homes and families, they come to Soulfree as their last hope. These are beneficiaries who are not able to take Soulfree's Rehabilitation due to comorbidities or other serious constraints, but they are literally struggling for day-to-day survival. So, Soulfree provides them with a monthly stipend of 2000-5000 for the period of one year. During this time, we counsel them and try to motivate them to become self-reliant. At the end of the year, the goal is that they will themselves say, "I am now able to support myself and my family financially. You can give the stipend to somebody else who is in need." This Monthly Stipend Program restores hope, dignity and a sense of being valued to the lives of beneficiaries. It is our oldest drive and it fulfils a vital need. Once they regain the confidence that they can survive in the world, everything becomes possible and the monthly stipend program gives them this initial boost.


